



Alliance of California Workshop Cancellation Policy. Please read carefully and print out if needed.

In the past year I have discovered that one of the hardest things about running an art studio is when someone who registers for a workshop does not show up or cancels at the last minute. This is especially difficult when the visiting instructor comes from far away and also has lodging/travel expenses to cover. Most likely, we have a student minimum that we have to meet in order to host the workshop – and the last-minute cancellation or no show of even one person can make a huge difference. I was hoping to not have to implement something like this, but unfortunately, we need to have it. I hope the policy below feels fair and reasonable – and I hope to see you at a workshop soon!

Cancellation Policy for Workshops at Alliance of California Artists

Workshops fill on a first come, first served basis. Your spot is not guaranteed unless you prepay for it, in full. This applies even if there is a payment option. All and final payments are due 4 weeks before the workshop. If you do not pay in full 4 weeks before the workshop your space may be given to someone who does pay in full by that time.

Cancellations 8 or more weeks prior to start of a workshop will receive a full refund.

For cancellations, less than 4 weeks before the workshop, we will only be able to issue a refund or studio credit for another workshop, if you are able to find a replacement for your reserved space.

Cancellations within 2 weeks of the start of the workshop, if you do not show up, or if you leave an event early for any reason, no credit or refund is available.
